It's the first day of school. You snap a photo in front of your house that has your house number in it. You think of texting it to your grandparents.

Discussion and answer:

DO I know and trust the people I'm thinking of sharing this with? **Yes, I** trust my grandparents.

HOW might this message make other people feel? *I think this photo will make my grandparents happy.*

HOW will I feel if my message ends up somewhere I didn't mean for it to be? *If someone I don't know sees this photo, I don't think I would feel that bad.*

COULD what I'm about to share make someone feel bad, ruin a friendship, harm someone's reputation, or put someone in danger, including myself? *No, this photo won't hurt anyone.*

Response: I would share this photo because I trust the people I'm sharing it with, and the photo won't hurt anyone.



Your best friend asks you to take a screenshot of a conversation you've had with someone else and send it to them.

Discussion and answer:

DO I know and trust the people I'm thinking of sharing this with? *I* might trust my best friend, but they do not need to see what I'm saying to someone else.

HOW might this message make other people feel? Sharing the screenshot could hurt the feelings of the person I was talking with. That person didn't give me permission to share our conversation.

HOW will I feel if my message ends up somewhere I didn't mean for it to be? I would not feel good if the screenshot of the conversation got shared widely. It was a private conversation.

COULD what I'm about to share make someone feel bad, ruin a friendship, harm someone's reputation, or put someone in danger,

including myself? Yes, it could ruin my friendship with the other person in the conversation.

Response: I would NOT share this screenshot because the conversation I had with the other person is private.



After an argument with someone you think of as a friend, you look through embarrassing videos you have of that person and think about posting one online.

Discussion and answer:

DO I know and trust the people I'm thinking of sharing this with? **No, I** don't trust everyone who is online.

HOW might this message make other people feel? *The embarrassing video could really hurt the person and make them feel bad.*

HOW will I feel if my message ends up somewhere I didn't mean for it to be? I would feel terrible if the video got shared widely. It could impact the person for a very long time.

COULD what I'm about to share make someone feel bad, ruin a friendship, harm someone's reputation, or put someone in danger, including myself? Yes, it could make the other person feel bad, ruin our friendship, and harm their reputation.

Response: I would NOT share the embarrassing video because it could cause a lot of harm to the other person, and maybe even myself.



Your dad is a good cook, and he makes a top secret new dish for an upcoming competition. You want to share a picture of it in your friend's group chat.

Discussion and answer:

DO I know and trust the people I'm thinking of sharing this with? *I might* know everyone in my group chat, but I might not be able to trust them all.

HOW might this message make other people feel? **People might get** excited to see the new dish, but it could also make my dad feel bad since it's supposed to be a secret for now.

HOW will I feel if my message ends up somewhere I didn't mean for it to be? I would feel bad if the picture got leaked and that hurt my dad's chances in the competition.

COULD what I'm about to share make someone feel bad, ruin a friendship, harm someone's reputation, or put someone in danger, including myself? Yes, it could make my dad feel bad because he's working hard for the competition. Sharing a picture could put his chance of winning at risk.

Response: I would NOT share the picture because I don't have my dad's permission, and it is a photo of something secret for an upcoming competition.



Someone in your group chat writes something mean and untrue about a friend you know who's not in the chat. You want to send a screenshot of the message to a group chat that includes that friend.

Discussion and answer:

DO I know and trust the people I'm thinking of sharing this with? **No, I** may not know everyone and trust everyone in the chat.

HOW might this message make other people feel? *The screenshot would* hurt my friend's feelings. Sharing it in a group chat might also embarrass them.

HOW will I feel if my message ends up somewhere I didn't mean for it to be? I would feel bad if the screenshot got shared widely, because it would spread the mean and untrue statements about my friend.

COULD what I'm about to share make someone feel bad, ruin a friendship, harm someone's reputation, or put someone in danger, including myself? *Yes, it could make my friend feel bad.*

Response: I would NOT share the screenshot because I don't want to spread negativity, and it would hurt the feelings of my friend. I would instead talk to a parent or trusted adult about what to do or talk to my friend privately in person.



You've just been added to the chat for a new friend group. You're thinking of sharing a funny photo of a close friend who's not in the group.

Discussion and answer:

DO I know and trust the people I'm thinking of sharing this with? **No, I** don't know or trust everyone in my new friend group.

HOW might this message make other people feel? The photo may make my friend feel bad because they may not want the photo to be seen by people they don't know.

HOW will I feel if my message ends up somewhere I didn't mean for it to be? I would feel bad if the photo got spread widely. People who don't know my friend well may take the photo out of context and not understand that it was shared with good intentions.

COULD what I'm about to share make someone feel bad, ruin a friendship, harm someone's reputation, or put someone in danger, including myself? **Yes, it could make my friend feel bad.**

Response: I would NOT share the photo because I don't have my friend's permission, and I don't know everyone in the friend group well.



You're at the aquarium. Your mom is on the way to pick you up, but she's stuck in traffic. You think about sharing your location with her so she can see where you are.

Discussion and answer:

DO I know and trust the people I'm thinking of sharing this with? **Yes, I** trust my mom.

HOW might this message make other people feel? Sharing my location with my mom will make her feel safe and help her find me.

HOW will I feel if my message ends up somewhere I didn't mean for it to be? *I'm not sure how I would feel if someone else got my location.*

COULD what I'm about to share make someone feel bad, ruin a friendship, harm someone's reputation, or put someone in danger, including myself? *No, sharing my location with my mom wouldn't make anyone feel bad.*

Response: I would share my location with my mom because she needs it to pick me up.
