Sign up for alerts and warnings in your area.

Public **safety officials use systems** to alert you about severe weather and disasters.



Make sure everyone knows the safest place in your home.

But first, <u>prepare your home</u>, <u>check that</u> your insurance is up to date, and choose an out-of-town contact. Plan for your <u>pets</u>, too.



Secure important documents.

Gather important papers in a waterproof "Grab and Go" box. Keep it handy.



Have an evacuation plan.

Check with local officials for **shelter locations**. Have a go-bag ready with hand sanitizer, masks, medications, and other essentials.



Stay in the know.
